#### Anna M. Kovalenko, Kyiv, Ukraine

#### Head of NGO 39th Sotnia (Feb 2014 - 2022)

After the Revolution of Dignity where I was the commander, I organized the NGO 39th Sotnia. I focused on supporting the Armed Forces of Ukraine in the war with the Russian Federation since 2014 as well as supporting the families of soldiers, their mothers, wives and children. We did the projects promoting the active participation of women in civic and political life, gender equality and anti-discrimination. Some NGO members have been fighting as part of combat brigades of the AFU (since 2014 until now). Since February 24, 2022, we have been collecting and transmitting accurate data on movements and the accumulation of enemy's military equipment and passing it to the AFU units. We created special informational-educational booklets for civilians and spread them to the media. We taught Ukrainian citizens in a safe and correct way to precisely document war crimes against civilians and transferred data to the Prosecutor General's Office. Being an expert of defense and security and having experience in the national top-management, I effectively and efficiently built up, coordinated and advanced the horizontal interaction between the state institutions and both national and international NGOs, helped civilians and military forces to find common language and successfully communicate with each other. We cooperated with various NGOs and searched for any other humanitarian aid both for civilians and the AFU and Territorial Defense units. We consulted the international organizations and continued coordinating them about the locations to be supplied urgently.

#### **Head of Chernihiv Oblast Administration (2020-2021)**

First woman chief of Oblast Administration on Volodymyr Zelenskyy's team. Established constructive dialogue between local and central governments against the background of national decentralization of executive power. Oversaw rise of temp of economic growth to reach 4th place among oblasts nationally, alongside significant reduction to risk of corruption on public procurement. I have developed and advanced the regional (oblast's) territorial defense and organized the training with a record-breaking attendance of 112 percent.

#### **Deputy Minister of Community and Territorial Development (2020)**

Responsible for development of regional development policy: established dialogue with security and defense agencies in context of decentralization of executive powers, head of State Committee for the resolution of emergency situations, developed a plan for regional development for 2021-202.

#### Deputy Chief of the Presidential Office for National Security and Defense, (2019-2020)

Developed sectoral reform strategies for the President's consideration in consultation with the Ukrainian and foreign experts. Also organized the interaction and coordination with the national security and defense sectors, such as ensuring and implementing the President of Ukraine's control over the activities of the AFU and other military units, the regular monitoring of the problematic issues in those sections as well as preparing the alternative solutions. In the country, the reform of Decentralization was established at the final stage. The President of Ukraine assigned me to deal with this direction and my candidacy was submitted to the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine to be appointed as the Deputy Minister of the Ministry of Regions.
